

# 2018 Student Achievement Data

## Executive Summary

Standard 8.1 of the Principles of Accreditation established by The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges requires the institution to identify, evaluate, and publish goals and outcomes for student achievement appropriate to the institution's mission, the nature of the students it serves, and the kinds of programs offered. The institution must use multiple measures to document student success.

In accordance with this standard, Grayson College established its goals for student achievement based upon the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board Accountability Report and the 60X30 statewide goals. The current Grayson College strategic plan 2020X2020 utilizes FY 2013 as the baseline for measuring improvements across twenty-one metrics.

As of FY 2017, Grayson College has met four of the established goals:

1. Maintain Summer Successful Course completion rates at or above 80%
2. Increase the percentage of students who Satisfy TSI Obligations in Reading to 60%
3. Exceed the statewide average for completers who are working within one year of award
4. Exceed the statewide average for first-time full-time credential seeking students who complete their degree or certificate within three years by 2% annually.

Six of the twenty-one metrics appear to be on track to be achieved:







1. Increase the successful course completion rates by 1% annually for fall courses
2. Increase the successful course completion rates by 1% annually for spring courses
3. Increase the course completion rates by 1% annually for fall courses
4. Increase the course completion rates by 1% annually for spring courses
5. Increase the number of students who transfer after completing at least 30 credit hours by 5% annually
6. Increase the percentage of students who satisfy TSI obligations in writing to 60%

The remaining 11 metrics are lagging or have seen a negative trend. Those metric are:

1. Award 2020 Certificates, Degrees, Occupational Skills Awards and Core Completers Annually by 2020
2. Increase Summer Course Completions Rates by 1% Annually
3. Increase Fall Course Conclusion Rates to 95%
4. Increase Spring Course Conclusion Rates to 95%
5. Maintain Summer Course Conclusion Rates at or above 95%
6. Maintain 95% in Licensure Exam Pass Rates
7. Increase the Percentage of Students Who Satisfy TSI Obligations in Math to 60%
8. Exceed the Statewide Average for Community Colleges Completers who Enrolled in Texas within One Year After Award
9. Exceed the Statewide Average for Community Colleges Completers who are Working or are Enrolled in Texas within One Year After Award
10. Exceed the Statewide Average for the Percentage of Students Completing a Degree or Certificate within Four Years by 2% annually
11. Exceed the Statewide Average for the Percentage of Students Completing a Degree or Certificate within Six Years by 2% annually

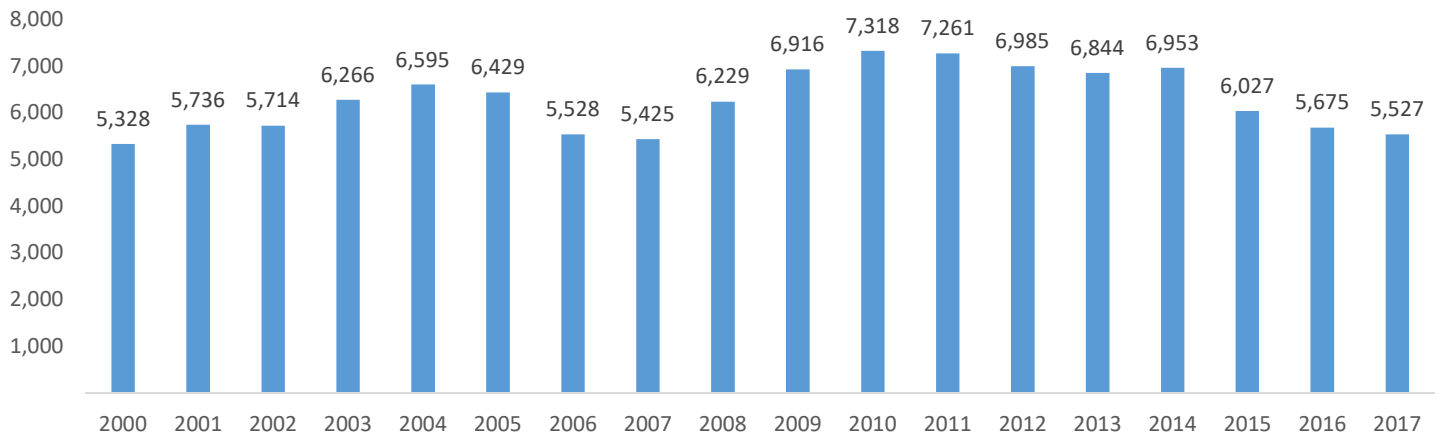

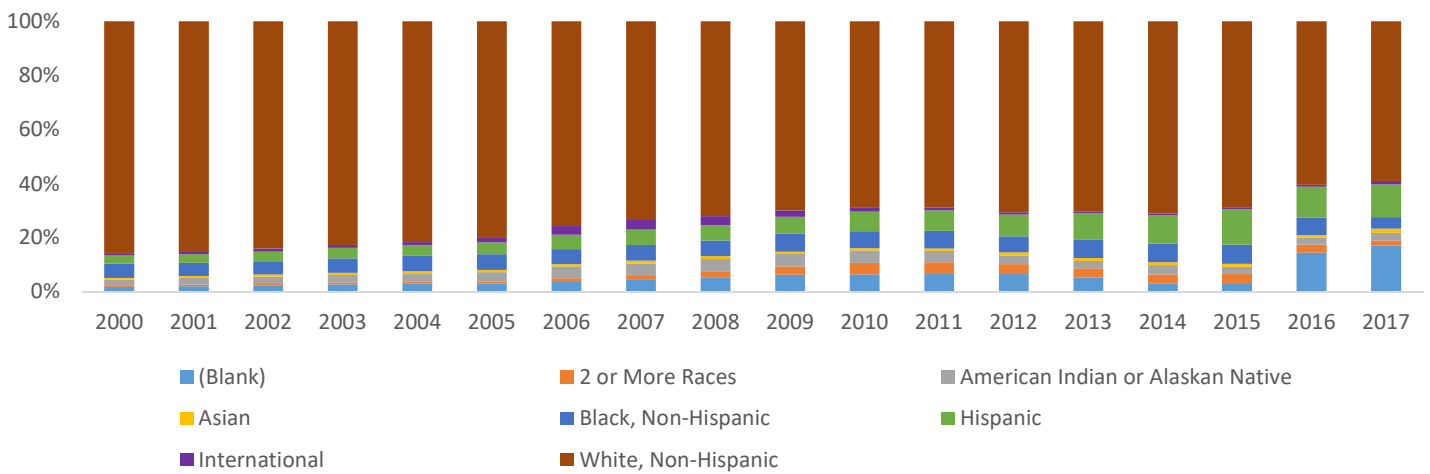

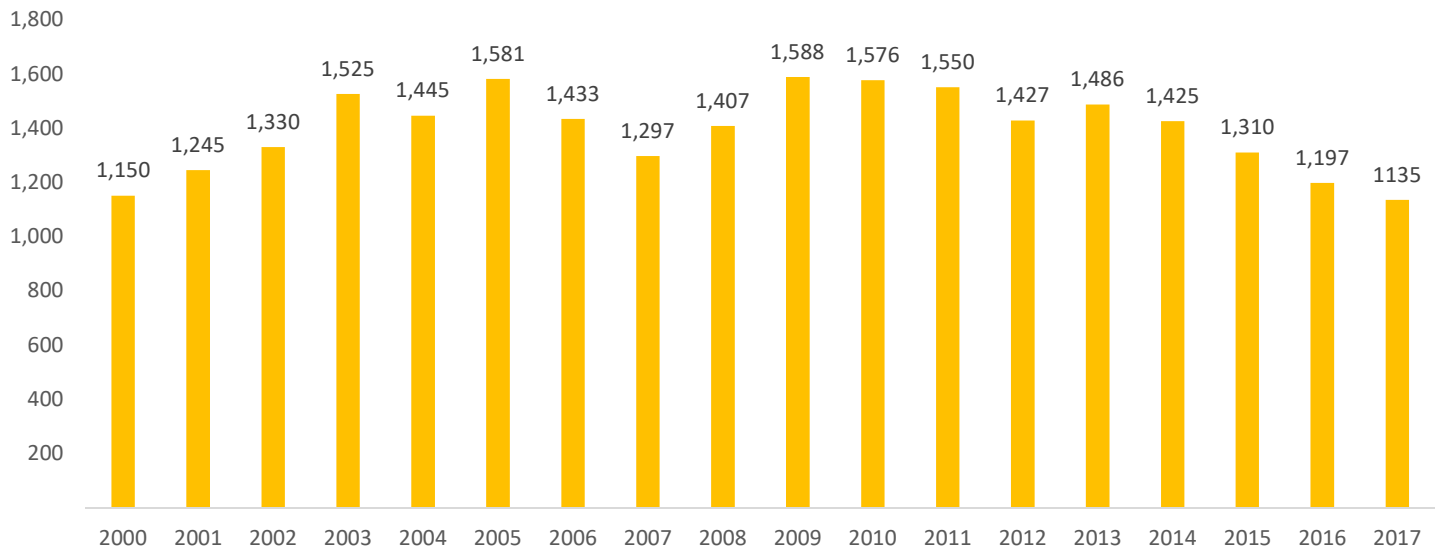
### Annual Unduplicated Enrollment



### Annual Unduplicated Percentage of Population by Ethnicity



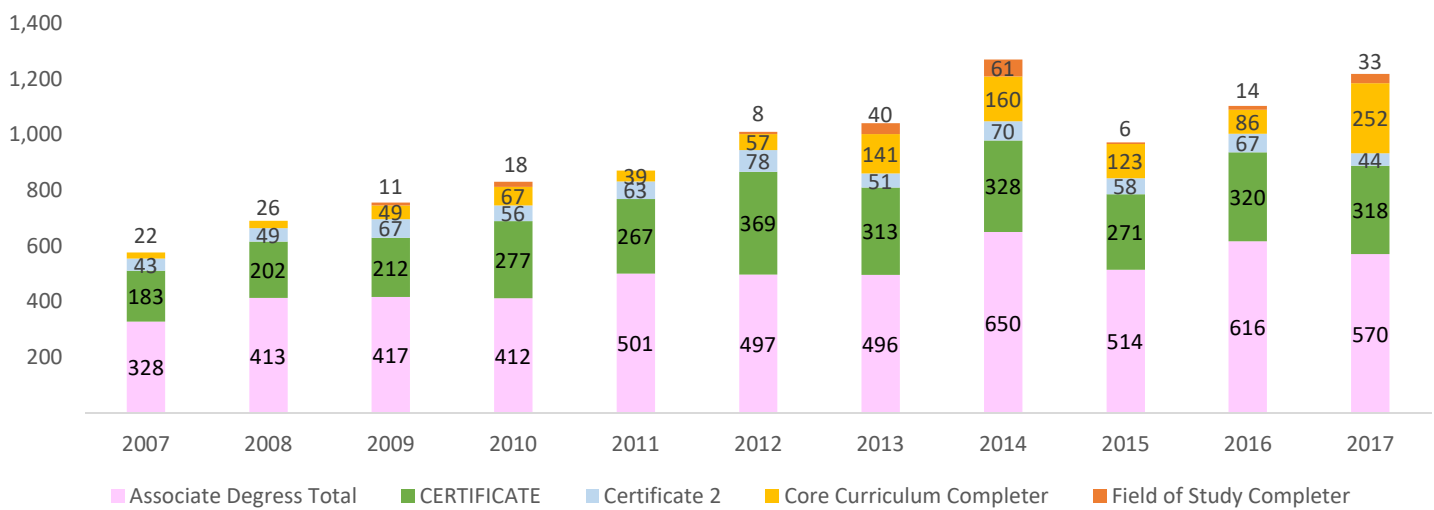
### Annual FTIC Starting Cohort



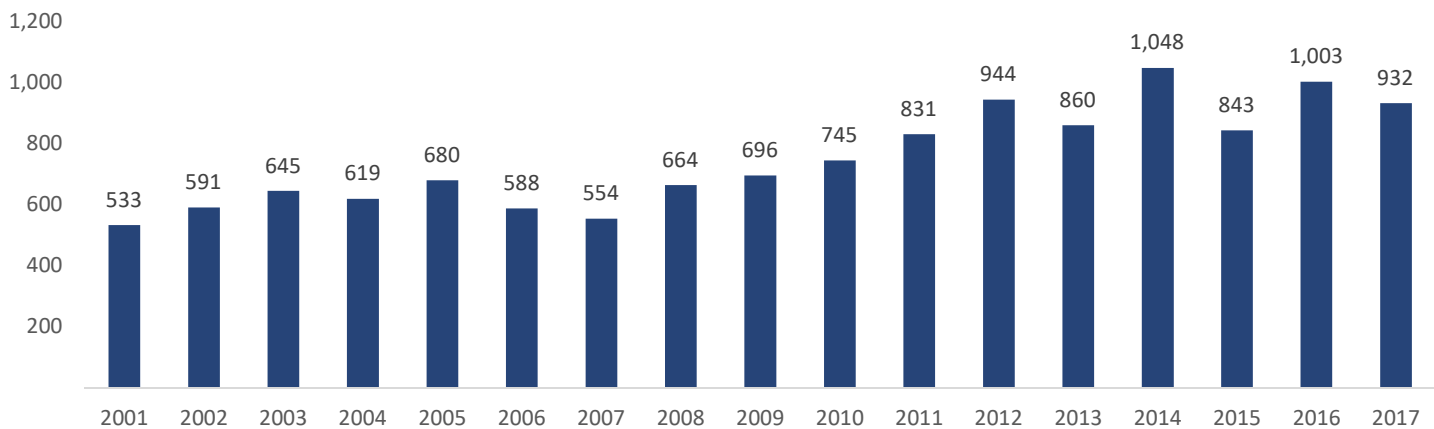
### Percentage of Starting Cohort who have Completed a Degree or Certificate



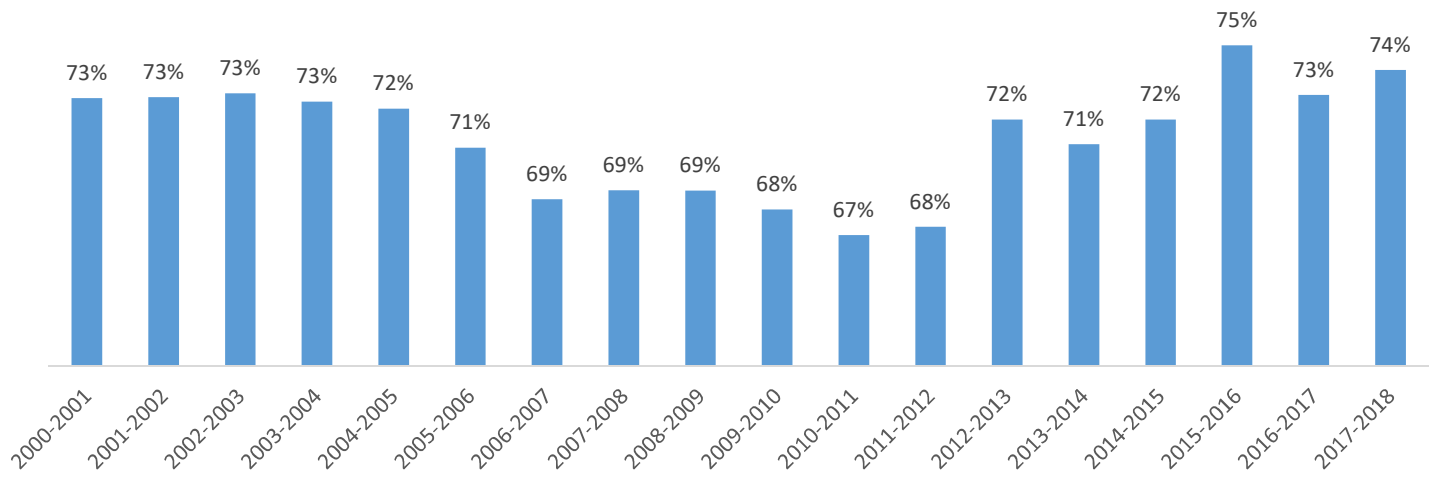
### Annual Degrees and Certificates Awarded



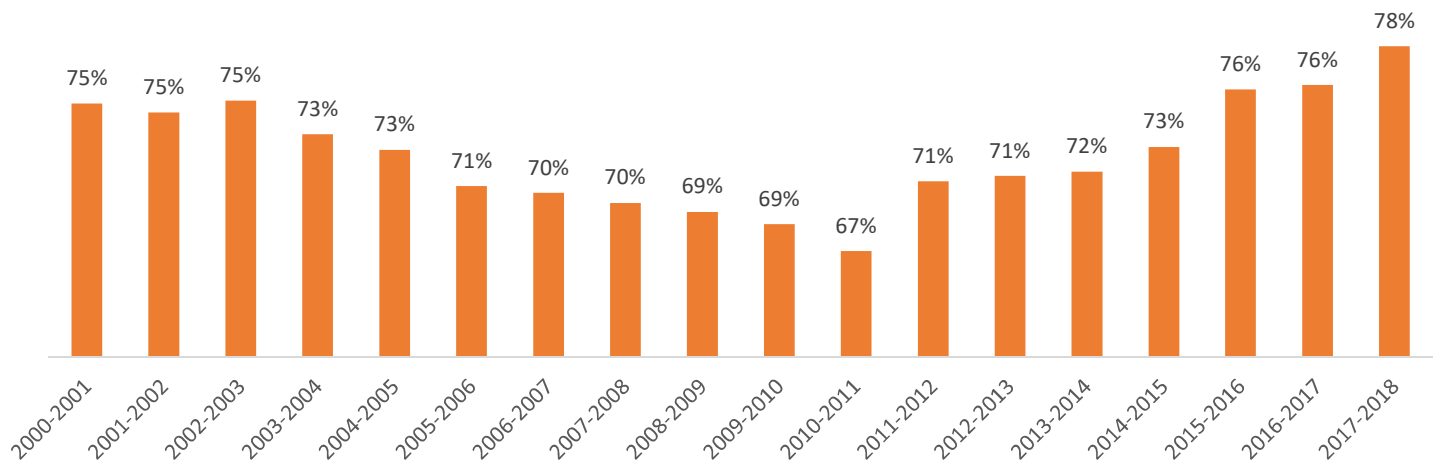
### Number of Degrees or Certificates Awarded



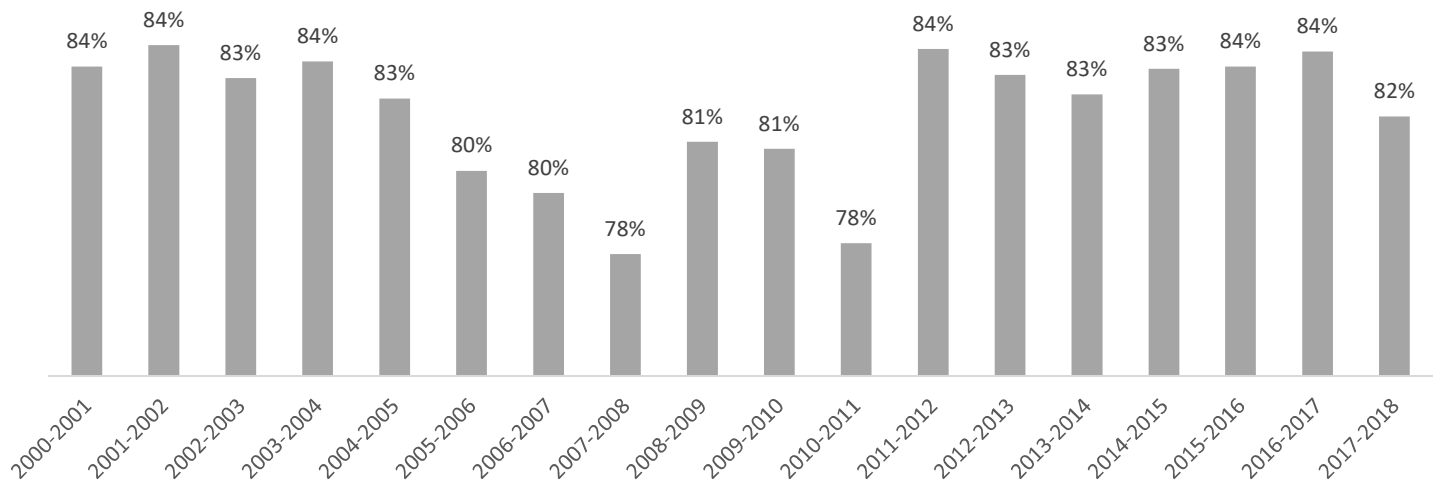
### Fall Semester Successful Course Completion Rate (A,B or C)



### Spring Semester Successful Course Completion Rate (A, B or C)

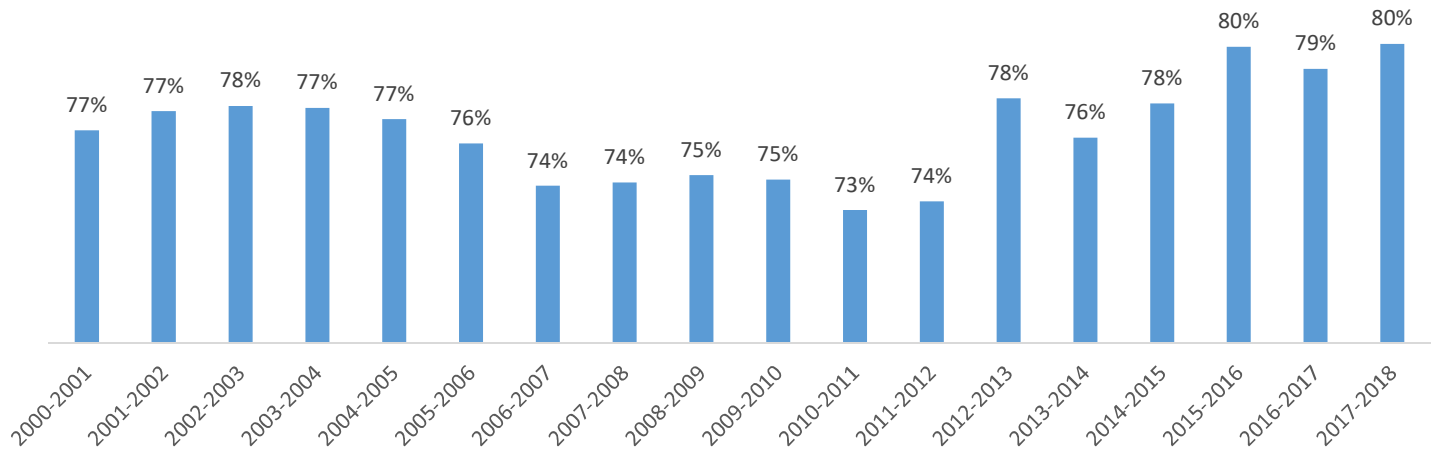


### Summer Semester Successful Course Completion Rate (A, B or C)

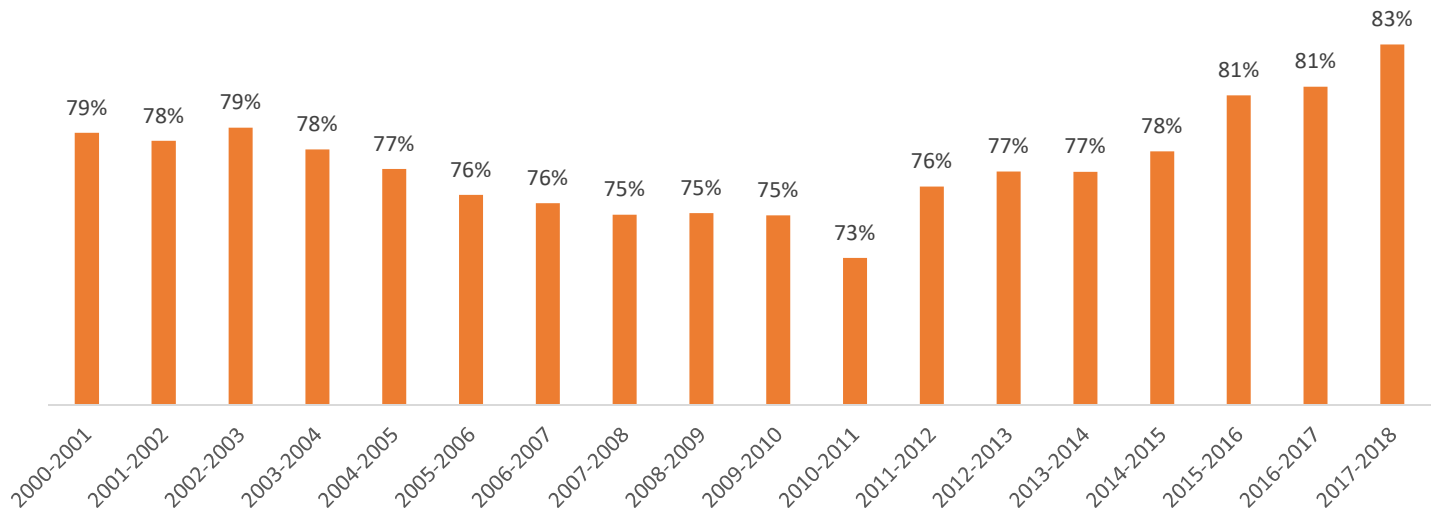




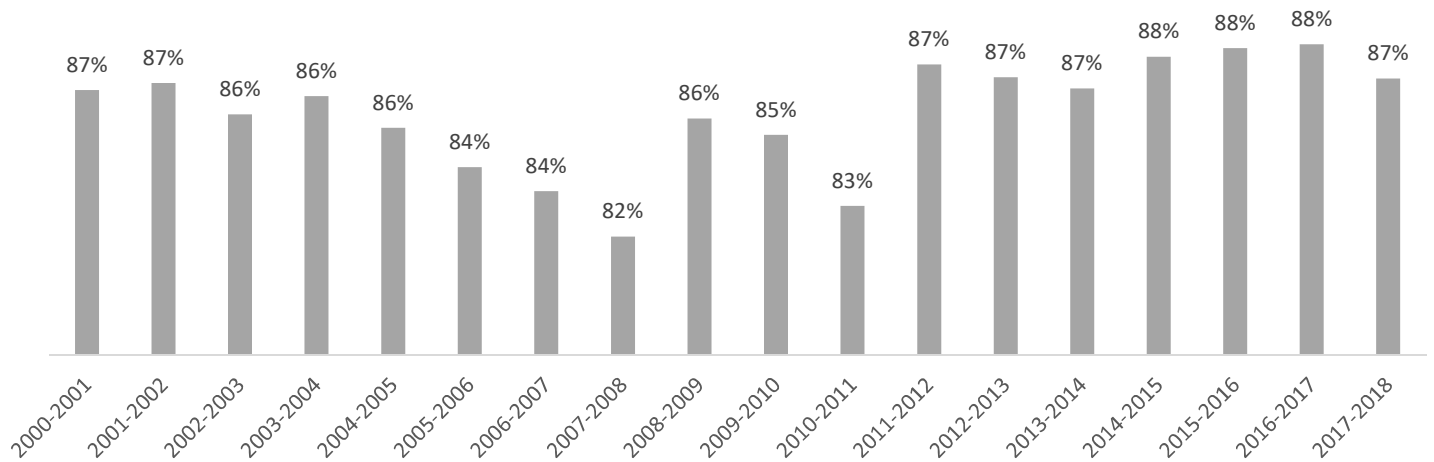
### Fall Course Completion Rates (A-D)



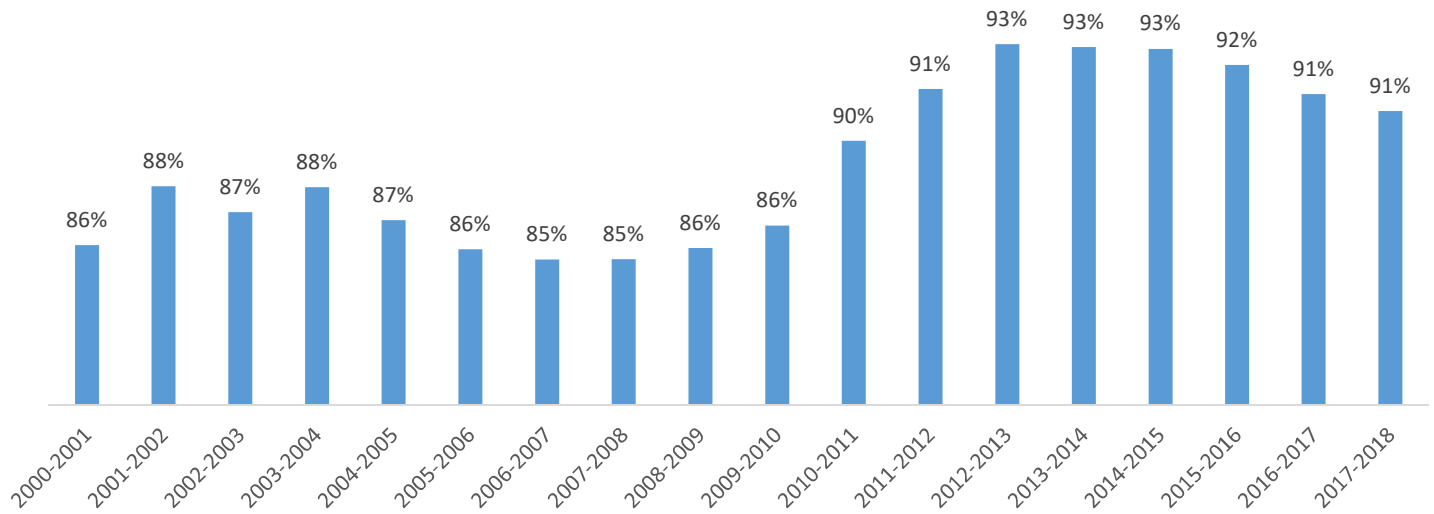
### Spring Course Completion Rates (A-D)



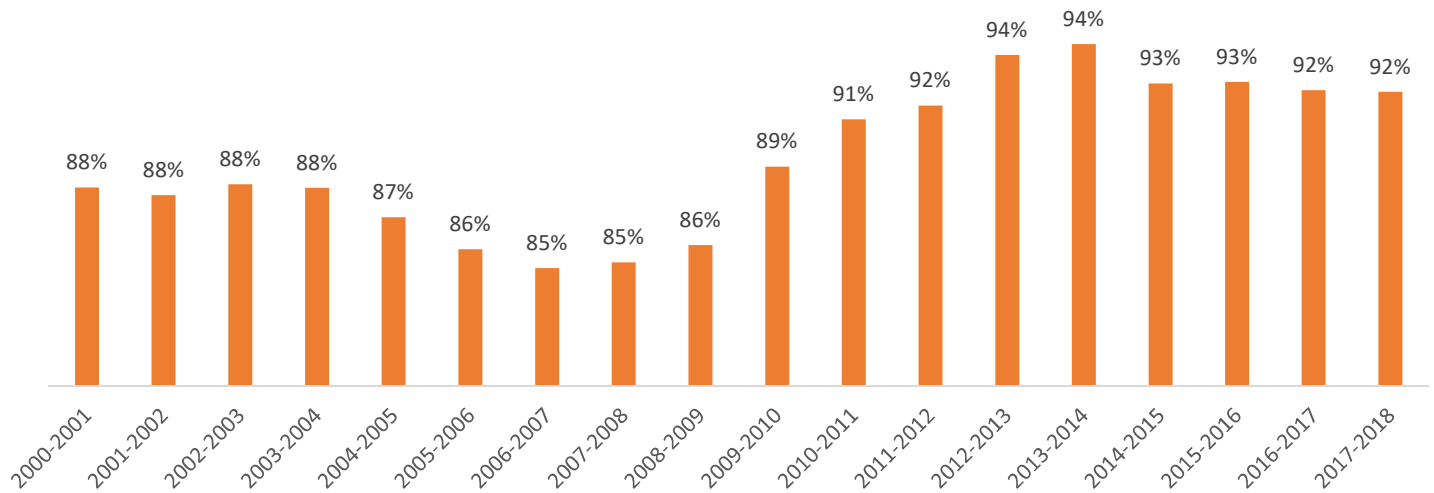
### Summer Course Completion Rates (A-D)



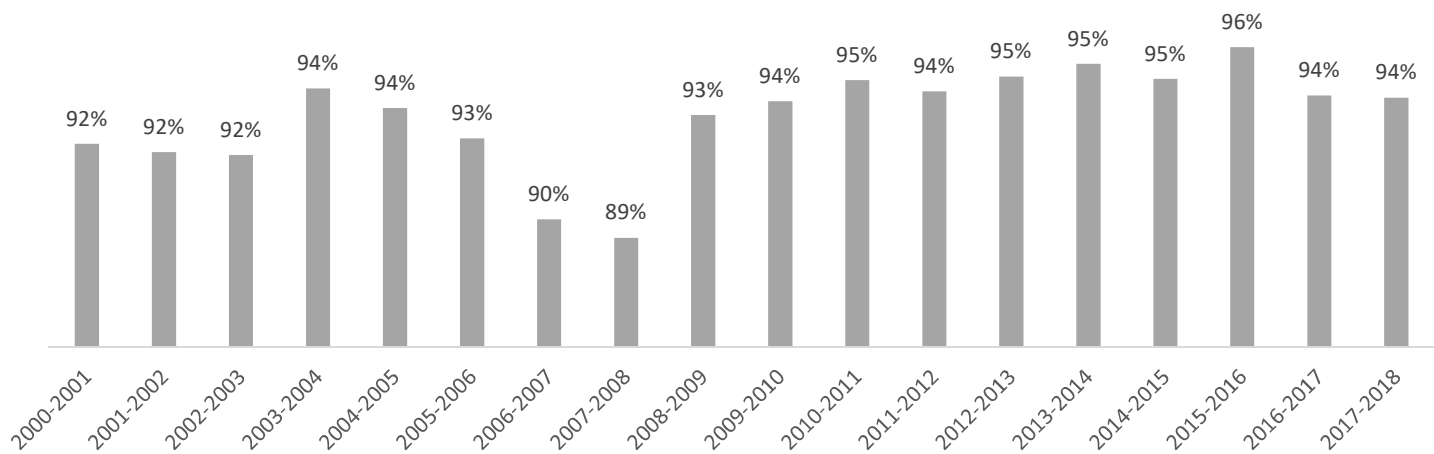
### Fall Course Conclusion Rate (A-F)



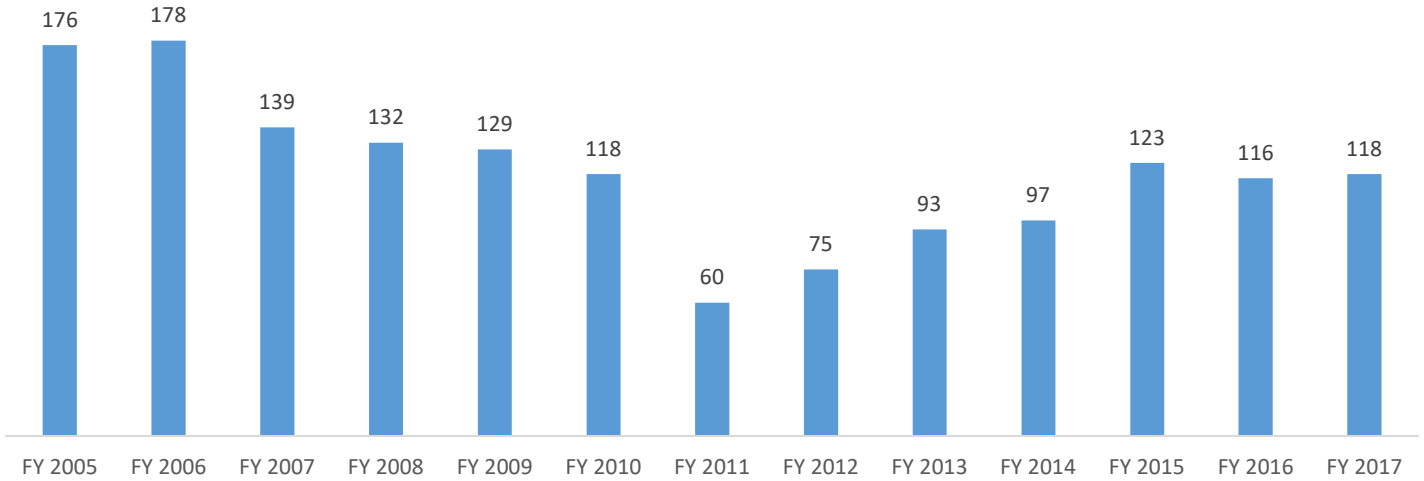
### Spring Course Conclusion Rate (A-F)



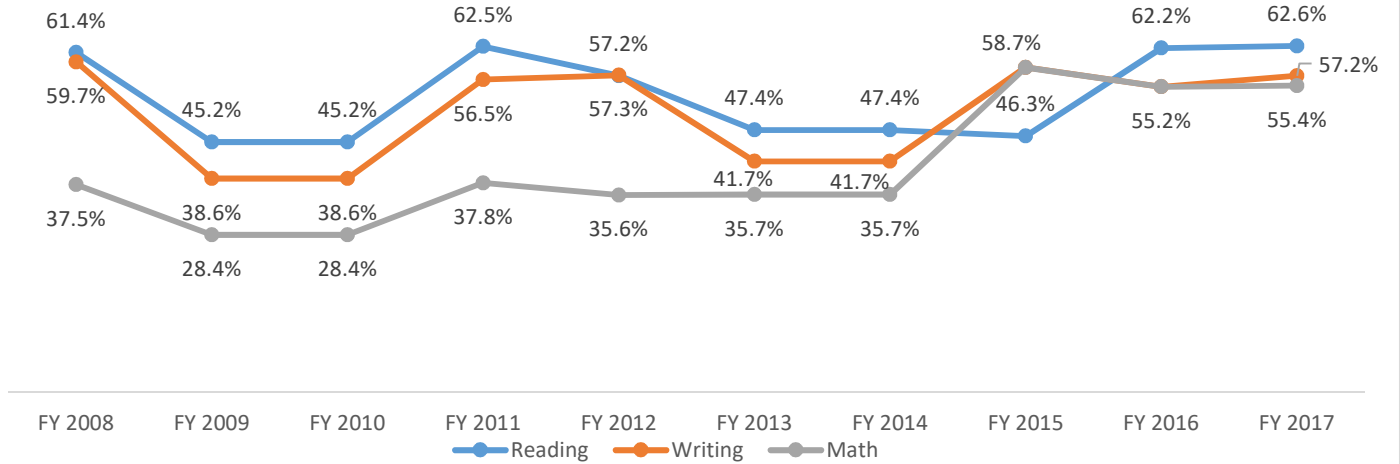
### Summer Course Conclusion Rate (A-F)



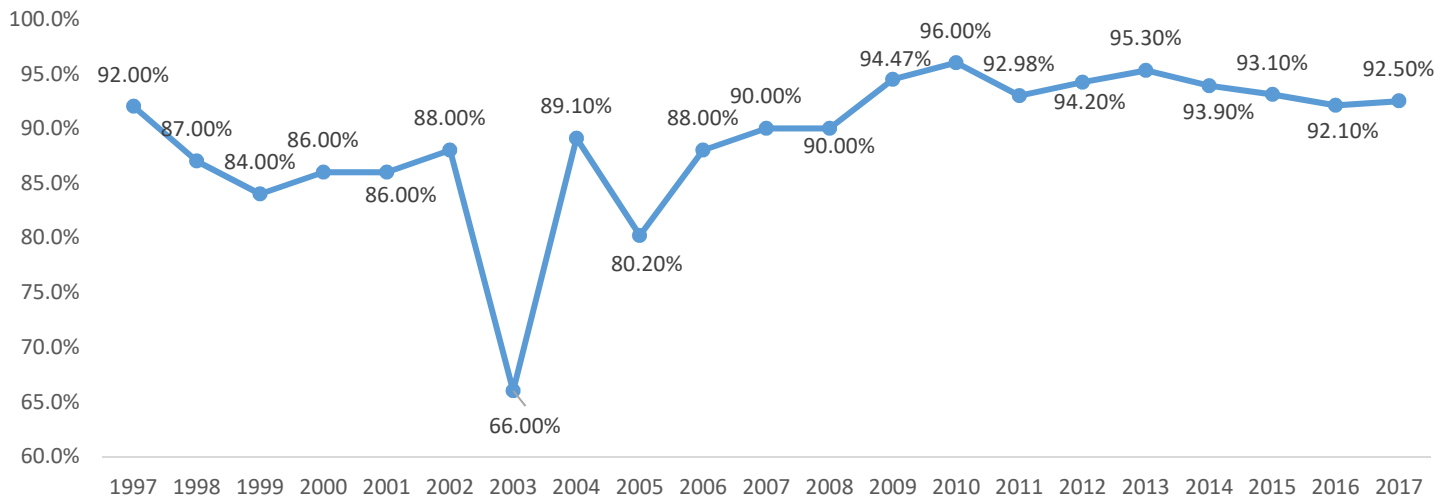
### Number of Students Who Transfer to a University



### Percent of Remedial Students Who Satisfy a TSI Obligation

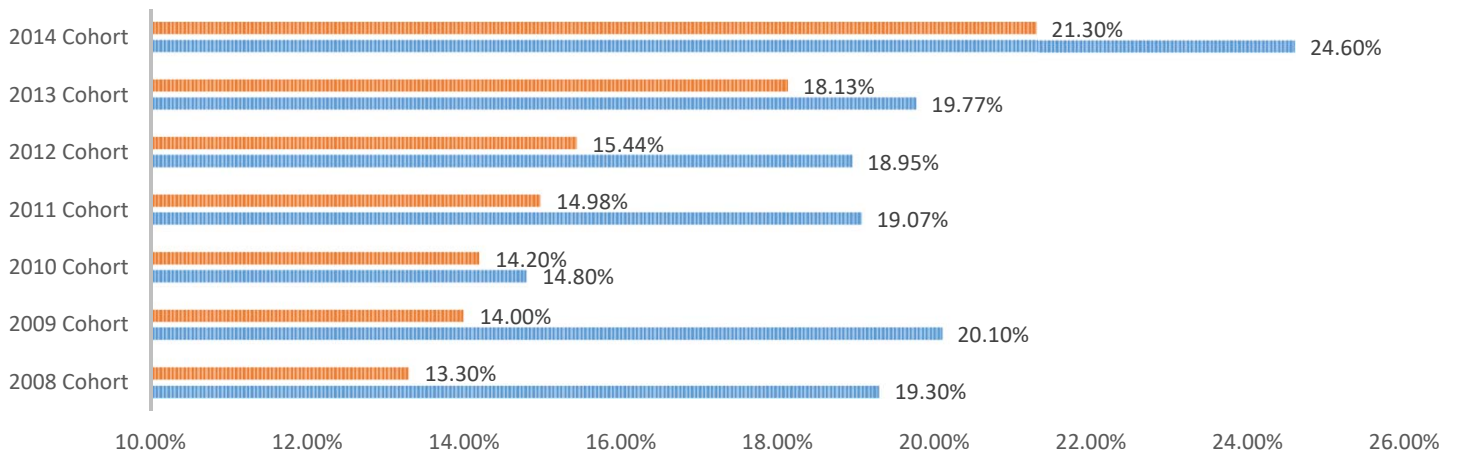


### Licensure Exam Pass Rates



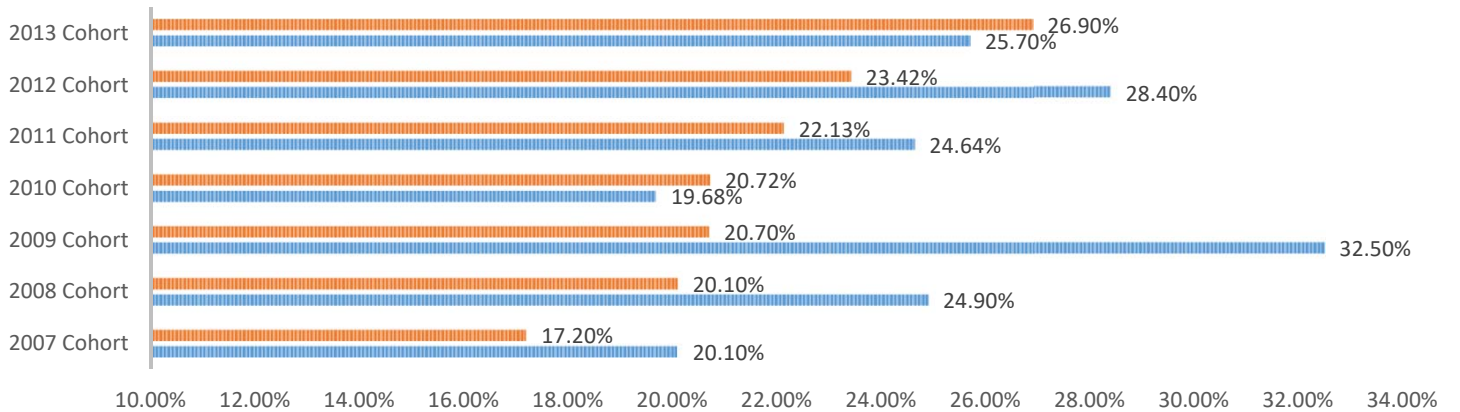
### THREE YEAR GRADUATION RATES

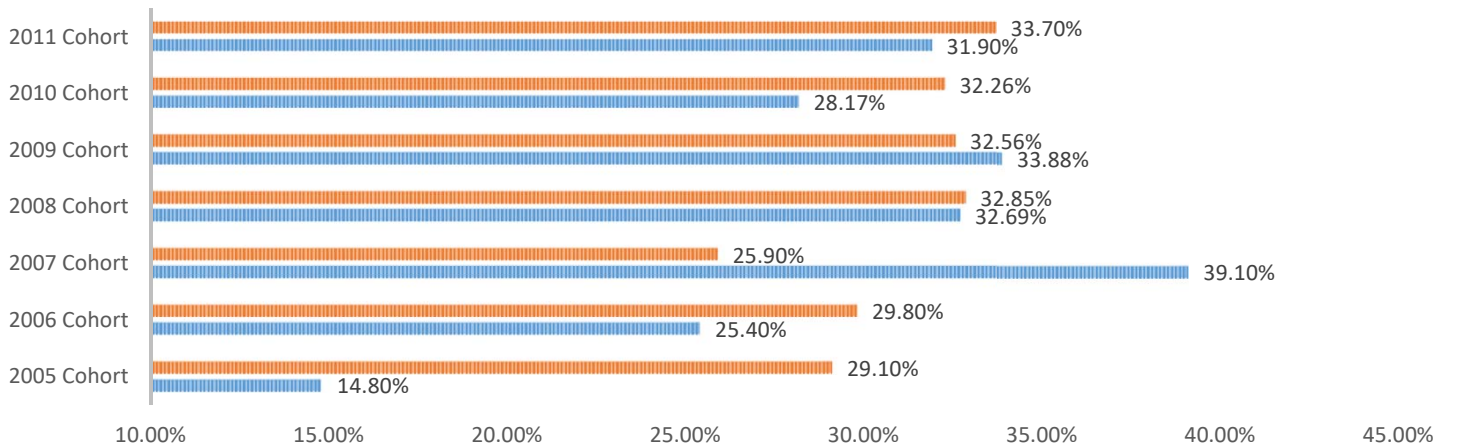
### FOUR YEAR GRADUATION RATES
