CLINICAL TEACHING ASSISTANT ASSOCIATE DEGREE NURSING PROGRAM

General Description

Under the supervision of a Master's or Doctorally prepared nursing faculty member, the Clinical Teaching Assistant will assist in the supervision of student's skill performance, student evaluation, and other aspects of student learning in the clinical and / or skills lab setting. Must be able to travel to clinical facilities and provide clinical instruction during 12 hour shifts.

Responsibilities: Work under the supervision of a Master's or Doctorally prepared nursing faculty member. Assist ADN program faculty with the supervision of students during clinical learning experiences, including nursing skills and computer laboratories, simulated clinical experiences, hands-on clinical care, clinical conferences and observational experiences. The faculty member must be present in the same facility and work with the CTA to supervise students with no more than a ratio of 15 students to 2 faculty.

Qualifications

Expected: Current license or privilege to practice as a Registered Nurse in the State of Texas. Clinical expertise to function effectively and safely in the designated area of teaching. Bachelor's degree in Nursing or higher.

- Certification
- Three (3) professional reference letters
