

Ray & Mary Morrison Transfer Student Scholarship Eligibility Requirements/Check List

Priority Deadline: May 15, 2018
General Deadline: July 31, 2018

Read the eligibility requirements carefully to determine if you are eligible to apply for the transfer student scholarship.

- 2018/2019 Morrison Transfer Student Scholarship Application**
Submit only one application per academic year. (see page 2 of this document)
- College Transcript(s)/GPA Requirement**
One copy of most recent college transcript. Unofficial copy will suffice. Scholarship applicants must provide a current academic transcript. Copy of most recent transcript must be provided each fall/spring semester before award funds can be processed. **If a current high school graduate, provide high school transcript.* Graduate of Grayson College, or a graduate of a Grayson County high school. Maintain a 2.8 or higher GPA. *Applicants with a GPA below 2.8 will not be considered.*
- Essay**
Neatly written or typed essay explain your career and education goals and how you plan to reach them; a personal statement such as extenuating financial circumstances, barriers to a college education, etc., if applicable; and any honors, awards, accomplishments, leadership positions, extracurricular activities and volunteer/community service activities.
- Letter of Recommendation**
Provide at least one letter of reference/recommendation from a professional (professor/employer/etc.) who is a non-family member.
- Proof of Full-time Enrollment**
Enrolled full-time and meet the scholarship eligibility requirements during the semester for which the scholarship is awarded to be eligible for subsequent semester. Provide proof of enrollment (copy of semester class schedule) at four-year university. Proof of enrollment must be provided each fall/spring semester before award funds can be processed.
- University Contact Person/Information**
Provide contact information for the individual at the university who processes outside scholarship awards. Contact information must include: name, mailing address, phone and email address.
- Residency**
A resident of Grayson County for at least three years.
- Awarding Cycle**
Morrison Transfer Scholarships are awarded once each academic year. Deadline to submit a completed application is May 15th. Scholarship awards are only available for the fall and spring semester. Scholarships can only be applied to the semester for which they are awarded. Recipient must provide previous semester transcript plus proof-of-enrollment for each fall/spring award semester. Scholarships are applied to the student's financial aid account at their transfer school
- Maximum Award Eligibility**
Morrison transfer student scholarships are awarded to qualified recipients for a maximum of 2 years.

Eligibility requirements to apply for scholarship: Graduate of a Grayson County High School, or Graduate of Grayson College; Maintain a 2.8 or higher GPA; a resident of Grayson County for at least three years; and full-time enrollment at transfer university

In order for the application to be considered, the following documentation must accompany the scholarship application: 1) Copy of most recent transcript showing a 2.8 or higher GPA, 2) Proof of enrollment at 4-year university (copy of class schedule) 3) Student essay, 4) Letter of Recommendation, and 5) University Contact Information

All new and renewal applicants must complete and file a scholarship application with the Grayson College Foundation Office prior to the May 15 deadline.
