

State law requires that each student identify any relation to a current Board of Regent member. A student who is related to a current member of the governing board of that institution is prohibited from receiving scholarship funds unless the scholarship is awarded exclusively based on academic merit or is an athletic scholarship. It is a Class B misdemeanor to file a false statement.

- Personal statement; Financial Resources, Single parent, etc.
- Awards or honors received.
- Community and/or school activities
- Extenuating financial circumstance, if any.
