



5 STEPS TO ADMISSION

APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID – Log in to: FAFSA.gov Click on “Start a new FAFSA”

1. APPLY TO GRAYSON – 3 STEP PROCESS (you MUST have a valid email address)

From the Grayson website, in the blue ribbon at the top of the page, Click on “Admissions and Aid”, select “Apply now”, Click on “Apply to Grayson College”. You should now be in Apply Texas.

1. Click on “Create your account now” to create your profile.
2. Validate your email address.
3. Log in to Apply Texas and create a blank application to Grayson College (2 year institution).

2. COLLEGE 101 ORIENTATION (you do not need a special login to complete this step)

1. From the Grayson website, in the blue ribbon at the top of the page, Click on “Admissions and Aid”, select “Apply now”, Select Step 2 – “College 101 Orientation”
2. On the first page, complete the [College 101 Entrance Survey](#). Several pages have a quiz at the bottom. Answer the quiz questions and check your answers, if incorrect, try again until you get them right. After completing the 20 pages, on the last page, open the “Exit Evaluation” and complete. **Note:** If you do not know your Student I.D. enter “unknown”

3. SUBMIT REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION TO THE ADMISSIONS OFFICE

- Meningitis Vaccination or exemption waiver for students under the age of 22.
- Official high school transcript with graduation date, or GED
- Official college or university transcripts
- Test scores that qualify for exemptions

To send a transcript electronically, **E-SCRIP** and **PARCHMENT** are the only forms of electronic servicing that we will accept. If unable to send electronically, you can mail it or hand-deliver it to the admissions office.

4. TEST SCORES & TSI ASSESSMENT

Students who do not have test exemptions are required by Texas law to have their academic skills assessed prior to enrolling in classes. If you are unsure if you meet the testing exemptions contact advising@grayson.edu

For testing exemptions you must meet one of the following criteria.

Associate’s degree or higher from an accredited college or university.
SAT: **Before 3-5-2016** 1070 Composite, 500 Critical Reading/Verbal, & 500 Math
After 3-5-2016 480 EBRW & 530 Math
ACT: 23 Composite, 19 English, & 19 Math
TAKS (11th Grade): 2200 ELA, 2200 Math, & 3 or 4 Essay
STAAR: English III Level 2 (score of 2000 in Writing and/or in Reading) & Algebra II Level 2 (score of 4000)
VETERANS: DD 214 Form

All test score expire 5 years after the test date.

To get to the Pre-Assessment: Go to Admissions and Aid – Testing and Assessment – TSI Assessment
