

Office of Financial Aid: Dropping a Class

This chart is to help you determine the number of credit hours required to meet the completion rate criteria to maintain (SAP) Satisfactory Academic Progress.

You must complete a minimum number of credit hours each year based on the number of credit hours that you attempt. Financial Aid Suspension occurs when your cumulative completion rate is less than 66.67% of the credit hours attempted.
