

College Success Council Meeting Minutes for August 22, 2018

Approval of Minutes from August 22nd Meeting: The minutes of August 22, 2018, were unanimously approved - a motion for approval was given by Dr. Williams and a second by Dr. Machen.

Updated on 60 x 30 Targets: Dr. Washburn shared that the Metroplex schools have not shared the numbers they submitted. We were aggressive with ours, so we are comfortable with what was submitted. There was a recommendation to use the numbers we submitted and second by Dr. Machen.

Dual Credit Free Class: Dr. Washburn shared a draft handout for High School Graduates (Dual Credit/Articulated Student). The handout includes a list of courses that could be offered as the free class.
