SUMMARY

Upon completing the Grayson College Dual Credit Cosmetology Program, students will be prepared to sit for the state licensure exam and work in a salon.

CERTIFICATE

Students will be eligible to sit for the TDLR licensure exam.

INSTRUCTOR

Grayson College provides course instructors.

CURRICULUM

The curriculum is provided by Grayson College and consists of materials located in the Canvas Learning Management System and hands-on lab activities.

SCHEDULE

Students attend regularly scheduled classes Monday – Thursday from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM.

Classes are held in a face-to-face format at the Denison campus.

VACCINATION REQUIREMENT
