SUMMARY

The Grayson College Dual Credit Radiologic Technology Program offers students the opportunity to explore a career in Radiology and complete prerequisites during their final year of high school. Upon completion, students will be eligible to apply for fall acceptance into Grayson College's Radiologic Technology Program with the added benefit of an extra point advantage in the application process. Once accepted into the Radiologic Technology Program, they will continue in a curriculum dedicated to the Radiology profession for five semesters. Upon graduation, students will receive an A.A.S. degree in Radiologic Technology.
